“Mass Brain Games Generator” is a Windows software that allows you to create “sudoky-like” games in bulk and their solutions with just one click.


The files are generated as .jpg files with an intuitive and sequential naming convention so you can easily identify the .jpg files that belong to the games and those that belong to the solutions.

## Using the Software

Using the software is really easy.

Step 1: Enter the number of games to create (max. 100 per run).

Step 2: Click “Create Games and Solutions!”
